What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A Neighbourhood Plan is document put together by the community which can guide the future development and growth of our area. It can contain a vision, aims, planning policies, proposals for improving the area or the allocation of key sites for specific kinds of development. We can vote to give it formal legal status.

Neighbourhood Planning Forums lead and coordinate the plan-making process to improve the social, economic and environmental wellbeing of their area. A group of local people are in the process of setting up a Levenshulme Neighbourhood Planning Forum to create a plan that will reflect Levenshulme's character and needs and now we need people to sign up as members.

Membership of the Neighbourhood Planning Forum is free and we want it to reflect the different parts of Levenshulme and different sections of the community. If you live or work in the area you can become a member and help to shape the plan. Don't worry, being a member doesn't involve lots of meetings – just giving us your views from time to time online, by e-mail or at community events.
